RULES & REGULATIONS

International Violin Competition “Josef Brandeisz” promote the talent of our participants and winners. The competition wants to encourage more young musicians to perform and grow.

We believe that our competition can offer many benefits to participants and help to build their confidence and realize their dreams. We welcome violinists of all nationalities.

GENERAL RULES:

International Violin Competition “Josef Brandeisz” is open to all nationalities and countries.

AGE CATEGORY: Applicants must have on March 1st 2016 the age mentioned below:

JUNIOR 1: 10-14 YEARS OLD

JUNIOR 2: 15-18 YEARS OLD

Conditions for entry

Registration in the violin competition will be made based on:

1. application form
2. copy of identity card / passport / born certificate for applicants under 14 years old
3. a recent color photo
4. copy of the bank confirmation for the payment of the registration fee

The registration fee is 50 Euro and will be paid as follows:

- The Selection's Registration Fees, net of Bank Charges amount to 25 Euro, will be paid up to deadline: 01.03.2016.

Copy of the Bank Transfer will represent the confirmation that the competitor will participate between 01-03.04.2016, at the final round in Timișoara.

Applicants should upload a video on YouTube and indicate the link in the Application Form.

The Selections will be made evaluating the video uploaded on YouTube by the Applicants.

The good quality video must be made with fixed angle, without editing.

The face of the Candidate, hands, piano keyboard or violin must be clearly distinguished.

The date and place of the recording must be specified and must not be made earlier than 2015.

The program of the uploaded video consists in one piece at own choice, medium level of difficulty. Duration max. of the recording is 15 min. for junior 1 category and 25 min. for junior 2 category.

After the 6th of March 2016 the Jury will evaluate the videos uploaded by the Candidates on YouTube.

The result of the Selections will be communicated personally to each candidate before the 10th of March 2016.

Hospitality

All participants' companion(s) (parent, accompanist or violin teacher) are responsible for their own expenses (travel, housing accommodations, etc.).

The organizers offer free housing accommodations to the participants **upon request**, during the competition.

For the participants' companions, the organizers will make hotel reservations upon request, based on special accommodation packages offer.

Upon arrival in Timișoara each competitor should report to the Competition Office and present a valid passport / ID document.

Children under 18 years old will be responsibility of their parents or legal guardian. And must be supervised all the time by their parents or legal guardian.

Competition Repertoire

Each competitor must prepare **two works at own choice from different periods (max. 20 min. for junior 1 category and max. 30 min. for junior 2 category)**, which demonstrate the contestants' abilities.

The works must be performed from memory.

The order of the performance is always left to the participant's own choice. The participants will bring their own accompanist. A list of official first-class accompanists will be provided to those participants who will have requested them on the application form. Their engagement will be made at the participants' own expense.

Scores

From 90 to 100: 1st prize (100/100: 1^o Absolut Prize)

From 80 to 89: 2nd prize

From 70 to 79: 3rd prize

Awards

The prizes will be: cash, accessories or scholarships. The total amount of awards is 1000 euro for each age category:

1st prize – 500 euro

2nd prize – 300 euro

3rd prize – 200 euro

1st, 2nd and 3rd winners of each age category will receive a diploma.

All performers in the violin competition will receive participation diplomas.

Jury

Prizes will be awarded by a Jury whose members are well known personalities of the musical world. The Jury will evaluate both the technical aspect and the expressive quality of the interpretation. The competitors may be asked by the Jury members to perform only excerpts from some works.

All the decisions of the Jury are final and non-appealable.

Each award-winner of the violin competition must receive his or her prize personally.

Copyrights

Competitors admitted to the Competition give the Organization rights to their performances in competition and Gala Concert.

By applying to take part in the competition, the applicants give their implied consent for this recording as well as for its transmission under the conditions mentioned above. The prizewinners have no claim to additional fees.

Final Dispositions

The infringement of rules has as consequence the exclusion from the violin competition, which is irrevocable, and/or taking pecuniary measures.
