

Vladimir Markovič was born in Pristina (Serbia) in 1967. His violin education began at the Music school "Mokranjac", in hometown. Continued his education at the school for musical talents in Cupria (Serbia). At 14, he became a student of the Music Academy in Novi Sad with prof. Pavel Vernjikov. After few months he moved to Moscow. In Moscow, he continued his education, first in the Central School at the Conservatory "P. I. Tchaikovsky". In 1986, entered the Conservatory Tchaikovsky with prof. Sergei Kravchenko - Department Kogan. He was the best Yugoslav participant in the competition "Jeusse Musical International Competition" in Belgrade 1991. And won the special award. He was received important awards all former Soviet Republics. His concert activity includes solo and chamber of performance. In his career, the most important tour is the Germany-Berlin, Italy-Milan, Monca, France-Paris, Greece-Crete, Cyprus, Thessaloniki, Serbia-Belgrade, Nis, Novi-Sad, Pozarevac. He collaborated with famous conductors: Rudolf Barsao, Konstantin Krimec, Pavel Kogan, Oleg Kagan. He has won international and republican prizes with his students. He was member of international jury: Belgrade – Petar Konjovic, Romania (Timișoara) – Alma Cornea-Ionescu, Eugen Cuteanu, wall as member of the jury of the Republican Competition.
