

**Yulia Berinskaya** was directed towards musical studies by her father, **Sergey Berinsky**, considered among the most important Muscovite composers of the twentieth century.

She attended the Gnessin School and later the Moscow Tchaikovsky Conservatory under the guidance of **E. Tchugaeva and V. Tretyakov**, from where she graduated with honors in 1992.

She was then invited by D. Schwartzberg to attend master classes at the Hochschule für Music in Wien, and in 1993 she won a scholarship from the Romanini Foundation in Brescia and moved to Italy, where, with the Quartet “Julia”, she won the award for best chamber ensemble in the International Music Competition “Città di Stresa”.

Her name is present in the most prestigious Italian concert seasons of chamber music, such as the Concert Society of Brescia, Como Autumn Music Festival, “Music and the Good” in Milan, Piacenza Concert Society, “Season of fifth Muse” Varenna, Bologna Festival. She has also performed at La Scala “Ridotto Arturo Toscanini”, the Press Club of Milan, the Milan Conservatory for the Association “Il Clavicembalo Verde”. She has been invited to perform at several international festivals of chamber music, having been largely successful in Spain, France, the Netherlands, Switzerland, Germany, the former Yugoslavia, United States of America, Russia, Israel, Greece.

She is a member of the **Trio Magritte** since 2012.

She has performed as a soloist with orchestras such as the Moscow Amadeus Orchestra, the Voroshilovgrad State Orchestra, the Sverdlosk Philharmonic (Russia), the Philharmonic Orchestra of Bacau (Romania), the Hamlet Orchestra of Monferrato Festival, the European Academy of Milan, the Orchestra of the Conservatory of Milan.

She took part in several Italian and International Festivals in Hungary, Austria, Germany, Spain, Croatia, Greece, Russia.

From 1994 to 2003, in collaboration with Pavel Vernikov, she taught at The “S. Cecilia” Academy of Advanced Violin in Portogruaro (Venice).

In 2001 she founded the School of Advanced Studies of violin at the New School of Music in Cantù and in 2005 she started up a masterclass in collaboration with the School of Classical Music and Arts in Mendrisio (Switzerland). Since 2009, she is the founder and head of the violin class at the “Milan Music Masterschool”.

She has held numerous masterclasses in Italy, in Cividale del Friuli, Maccagno, Cremona, Val Tidone, Pergine, Campobasso and abroad in Budapest and Moulin d’Andè.

A jury member in international violin competitions such as the “Michelangelo Abbado” in Milan, “A. Curci” in Naples, “Young Talents” (Monza e Brianza), “Rodos International Festivals Competition”.

Host of the shows: “Classica Radio” and “Classica Viva Web Radio” with her records “Violin in Blue”, “Violin in White” and “Violin in Bach”.

She has recorded for different labels: Koch Records (Germany) and Gramsapis ArtClassic (Russia), SonArt Studio, Suonare News, Classica Viva, Limen Music Free Web TV of Music and Arts.
